Thai Agri Minister Emphasizes the Use of Sustainable Production  
to Achieve SDG Goals by 2030



*Minister of Agriculture and Cooperatives attended the Global Forum for Food and Agriculture in Berlin, Germany. He stressed the importance of the agricultural sector and a commitment to implement sustainable production system to achieve the SDG goals by 2030.*

On January 18th, 2024, Captain Thammanat Prompao, Minister of Agriculture and Cooperatives, along with other Agricultural Ministers from over 80 countries around the world, attended the opening ceremony of the Global Forum for Food and Agriculture. Also in attendance were Mr. Sedthakiat Krajangwong, Deputy Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives (MOAC) and Director of Office of Agricultural Affairs, Brussels. The event was held at Messe Berlin Conference and Exhibition Center in Germany.

The objectives were to address the importance of agricultural sector and a commitment to apply sustainable production system. All groups of people will have access to safe and good quality food. The goals were also to reduce food waste, resolve hunger problems, ensure food security and nutrition as well as achieve SDG goals by 2030.

In the event, Minister of Agriculture of Sierra Leone, experts from IFAD (United Nation International Fund for Agricultural Development) and leading universities were invited to discuss on ways to accomplish Zero Hunger challenges in the next 7 years. Attendees, particularly new generation farmers, including the owner of vertical indoor farms in Thailand, have shared their view and participated in the robust discussion.
